

# Folded Tree Ornament

## Supplies:

- 2 Holiday Cotton Fabrics
- Star Button
- Hanging Cord
- piece of fusible tape (optional)
- Decorative thread for topstitching (optional)

## Instructions

Cut out an 8" circle of fabric.

Cut the circle in half.

Lay each half on contrasting fabric right sides together.  
(Makes 2 trees).

Sew with a scant 1/4" seam leaving a 2" opening on the straight side.

Turn and press. Optional – stitch opening closed or use fusible tape.

Optional – topstitch around using decorative thread and decorative stitch.



## Fold into tree shape:

**Fold 1** - Start with the straight edge on the left side of the tree. Make a soft fold on the right so the right side is about 4-1/2" and the fabric meets the left edge about 1" from the bottom.

**Fold 2** - Pivoting at the top of the tree, make a second fold bringing the fabric to the right side making a tree shape.

**Fold 3** - Fold the fabric back to the left side. It will meet the left side about 2" from the bottom.

**Fold 4** - Bring the fabric back to meet the right side.

Adjust folds so the edges are even then press.

Optional – tack edges or use fusible tape to keep layers together.

Add star or bell to the top and add a hanging cord.
